Dimapur Crushes Tuensang by 284 Runs in a Record-Breaking Win at the 5th Late G. Rio Men's U19 Tournament 2025

Dimapur delivered a dominant performance to register a massive 284-run victory over Tuensang in a completely one-sided encounter at the Nagaland Cricket Stadium, as part of the 5th Late G. Rio Memorial Men's U19 Inter-District Cricket Tournament 2025.

1st Innings – Dimapur: 308/10 in 47.4 Overs

After being put in to bat, Dimapur posted a formidable total of 308 runs, thanks to a brilliant century from Anirudh Yadav, who scored 102 off 86 balls, and a valuable 61 from Shiva Yadav. The pair laid a solid foundation and kept the scoreboard ticking with positive intent throughout the innings.

Despite the challenging task, Tuensang's bowlers showed some fight, with Shumritsa claiming 3/57 in 10 overs, and Phololi finishing with 3/75 in 10 overs.

2nd Innings – Tuensang: 24/10 in 11.5 Overs

In reply, Tuensang's batting collapsed under pressure and they were bowled out for just 24 runs in 11.5 overs, recording one of the lowest totals of the tournament. Zakaria Hussain was the top scorer with 5 runs off 32 balls, as wickets fell in quick succession.

Dimapur's Samir Ali produced a devastating spell, taking 6 wickets for just 3 runs in 3.5 overs, tearing through the Tuensang lineup with pace and precision. His extraordinary performance ensured Dimapur's emphatic victory and sealed his selection as the Player of the Match.

Chümoukedima Secures 5-Wicket Win Over Zunheboto in the 5th Late G. Rio Men's U19 Tournament 2025

Chümoukedima registered a confident 5-wicket victory over Zunheboto in their group stage clash of the 5th Late G. The match featured a strong all-round performance from Bendang Wapang, who played a key role in the team's success.

1st Innings – Zunheboto: 124/10 in 32.0 Overs

Zunheboto won the toss and elected to bat first. They posted 124 runs before being bowled out in 32 overs, with Nikato Zhimo leading the charge with a composed 53 off 55 balls.

Chümoukedima's bowling attack kept things under control throughout the innings, with Bendang Wapang delivering a crucial spell of 4 wickets for 50 runs in 8 overs, effectively breaking key partnerships and keeping the scoring in check.

2nd Innings – Chümoukedima: 130/5 in 33.0 Overs

Chümoukedima made a steady start in their chase and reached the target in 33 overs, finishing with five wickets in hand. The innings was built around Keshav Thakur's gritty 42 off 84 balls, while Aloto Sumi added quick runs with a powerful 41 off just 24 deliveries, sealing the match in style.

Zunheboto's bowlers tried to apply pressure, with Romit Saha taking 1/14 in 3 overs, but the total proved insufficient to defend.
