Niuland Defeats Chümoukedima by 44 Runs in T20 Clash at the 5th Late G. Rio Men's U19 Tournament 2025

In an exciting T20 fixture of the 5th Late G. Rio Memorial Men's U19 Inter-District Cricket Tournament 2025, Niuland emerged victorious with a 44-run win over Chümoukedima at the Sovima Cricket Ground, Chümoukedima. The match was marked by a composed half-century from Jeetender Yadav and a strong bowling performance led by Abhay Tripathi.

1st Innings – Niuland: 134/8 in 20.0 Overs

After being put in to bat, Niuland posted a competitive total of 134/8 in their allotted 20 overs. Leading the charge was Jeetender Yadav, who anchored the innings with a well-constructed 56 off 50 balls, setting the platform for a defensible score.

Chümoukedima's bowlers shared the wickets, with Aloto Sumi, Akesho, and Viriekholie Dzeyie all picking up 2 wickets each, applying pressure at regular intervals and keeping the total in check.

2nd Innings – Chümoukedima: 90/10 in 19.5 Overs

Chasing 135 for victory, Chümoukedima's batting lineup struggled to build partnerships and were eventually bowled out for 90 runs in 19.5 overs. Aloto Sumi (22 off 19) and Akesho (21 off 33) offered some resistance, but the team fell short of the target.

Niuland's bowling attack was sharp and disciplined, with Abhay Tripathi delivering an excellent spell of 3 wickets for 11 runs in just 2 overs, derailing Chümoukedima's chase early on.

Player of the Match: Jeetender Yadav (Niuland)



For his match-winning knock of 56 off 50 balls, Jeetender Yadav was named the Player of the Match, playing a key role in setting up the win for Niuland.

1st Innings – Mokokchung: 65/10 in 15.4 Overs

Mokokchung, opting to bat first, struggled to gain momentum and were bowled out for just 65 runs in 15.4 overs. Livoto top-scored with a quick 21 off 14 balls, but lacked support from the rest of the batting order.

Peren's bowling unit was led by an outstanding spell from Amrit Tiga, who ripped through the lineup with figures of 5 wickets for 10 runs in just 3.4 overs, breaking the backbone of Mokokchung's innings.

2nd Innings – Peren: 66/5 in 11.1 Overs

Chasing a modest target, Peren lost early wickets but managed to reach the finish line in 11.1 overs, with five wickets in hand. Amit Marak anchored the chase with a composed 20 runs off 26 balls.

Mokokchung's Amongti Lkr tried to fight back with the ball, claiming 4 wickets for 19 runs in 4 overs, but the low total left little room for error.

For his exceptional spell of 5/10 in 3.4 overs, Amrit Tiga was named the Player of the Match, delivering one of the most impactful bowling performances of the tournament so far.
