Niuland Registers 5-Wicket Win Over Zunheboto in the 5th Late G. Rio Men's U19 Tournament 2025

1st Innings – Zunheboto: 119/10 in 29.2 Overs

Winning the toss, Zunheboto elected to bat first. Their innings was carried single-handedly by Nikato Zhimo, who played a stellar knock of 79 runs off 69 balls, accounting for the majority of the team's total. However, the rest of the batting order failed to provide support, and Zunheboto was eventually bowled out for 119 runs in 29.2 overs.

Niuland's bowlers put in a disciplined effort, led by Sajid Laskar, who returned with figures of 3/20 in 7 overs. He was well supported by Rizwan, who chipped in with 2 wickets for just 9 runs in 2 overs, restricting Zunheboto to a modest total.

2nd Innings – Niuland: 120/5 in 31.4 Overs

Chasing 120 for victory, Niuland paced their innings steadily, despite losing five wickets. Jeetender anchored the chase with a composed 38 off 40 deliveries, guiding his team through the tricky phases of the match.

Zunheboto's bowlers tried to defend the low total with some tight spells, particularly from Hino Zhimo (2/19 in 9.4 overs) and Oloka B Rochill (2/33 in 9 overs), but the target proved insufficient.

Niuland reached the target in 31.4 overs, clinching a solid 5-wicket win and moving forward in the tournament with confidence.

1st Innings – Dimapur: 122/10 in 32.5 Overs

Winning the toss, Dimapur opted to bat first but struggled to build momentum throughout the innings. They were bowled out for 122 runs in 32.5 overs, with Shyerinlo being the top scorer, contributing 19 runs off 33 balls.
